### **Unprecedented partnership between three major ski resorts**

Appreciative of the added value that the inter-resort exchange days represent for their pass holders, the ski lift companies in 4 Vallées, Portes du Soleil and the Aletsch Arena have entered into a new partnership for the 2018-19 winter season. Initially launched during the 2017-18 winter season, this freshly renewed partnership will allow all pass holders from one of the resorts to enjoy five free days at the other two partner destinations.

These three world-renowned ski areas provide over 1100km of pistes that are open to everyone. As well as downhill skiing, each resort has its own particular attractions which are enjoyed by people of all ages. In the Aletsch Arena, it is the remarkable beauty of the Aletsch glacier – the largest in the Alps – that catches the eye. Portes du Soleil offers a network of 12 resorts that straddles Switzerland and France. It caters for skiers of all levels and offers a range of different atmospheres, not to mention the famous “Rock the Pistes” festival. In 4 Vallées, skiers can admire incredible views of the most beautiful peaks in the Alps from the summit of Mont-Fort, which stands at an altitude of 3,330 metres, as well as enjoying the marked and secured freeride routes that are left unprepared so that everyone can enjoy the pleasure of powder snow.

Thanks to their altitude and their outstanding snowmaking facilities, these areas can guarantee the best in skiing from November through to the end of April – which means there is plenty to look forward to next winter.
